Water Bottles

Send your student(s) to school with a water bottle. It's important to stay hydrated throughout the day, especially during warmer weather. There is a water station where students can refill their water bottle.

Spring Sports

Registration is OPEN for spring sports. Season to start Mid-March. Practice times are TBD.

How to register:

Registration is done online through FamilyID. Using a computer is preferable over a cellphone. Please go here: https://hello.familyid.com/

*Click the high school when registering then please select **23/24 Middle School Spring Athletics**.

Sports fee \$100. Payment or a payment schedule needs to be made by the first game. If a student plays a 3rd sport through HMS, the fee is \$50. We accept cash, check or card. Please pay at the front office.

Students will be ineligible to participate/play if:

- No physical on file
- No payment/payment plan in place
- 15 minutes tardy to first period or any class throughout day (unless otherwise unexcused)
- Not registered on FamilyID

If a student is 15 minutes or more late to first period, then that student may not participate in that day's athletic events. If your student has a doctor/dentist appointment, a physicians' note is required in order for absences to be excused. If a student is not well enough to come to school, then it will be determined that they are not well enough to participate in that day's sporting events. HOW WILL MY ATHLETE GET TO AWAY GAMES?

HMS does not provide bussing to away games. Parents or family members must transport students. Student athletes can also ride with a coach or another parent but transportation forms need to be filled out at the office.

WHEN ARE PRACTICES?

Practices are typically right after school but days/times may vary depending on the coach. Please reach out to coaches for practice schedules.

Attendance Matters. Please make sure you are calling or emailing the front office to let us know when your student is absent. If your student has a Doctor or Dentist appointment, we prefer a note excusing their absence be brought in. Thank you for understanding!



Students can go to school if:

- They have a runny nose or little cough, but no other symptoms
- They haven't taken any fever-reducing medicine for 24 hours, and have been fever-free during that time
- They haven't thrown up or had diarrhea for 24 hours

Keep students home if:

- They have a temperature higher than 100 degrees even after taking medicine
- They are throwing up or have diarrhea
- Their eyes are pink and crusty

Call the doctor if:

- They have a temperature higher than 100 degrees for more than two days
- They've been throwing up or have diarrhea for more than two days
- They've had the sniffles for more than a week, and aren't getting better
