How to register:

Sports fee \$100. Payment or a payment schedule needs to be made by the first game. If a student plays a 3rd sport through HMS, the fee is \$50. We accept cash, check or card. Please pay at the front office.


Students will be ineligible to participate/play if:

- No physical on file
- No payment/payment plan in place
- 15 minutes tardy to first period or any class throughout day (unless otherwise unexcused)
- Not registered on FamilyID

If a student is 15 minutes or more late to first period, then that student may not participate in that day's athletic events. If your student has a doctor/dentist appointment, a physicians' note is required in order for absences to be excused. If a student is not well enough to come to school, then it will be determined that they are not well enough to participate in that day's sporting events. - Their eyes are pink and crusty


Call the doctor if:

- They've been throwing up or have diarrhea for more than two days
- They've had the sniffles for more than a week, and aren't getting better
