NINE WEEKS TESTING PROCEDURES:

- All tests must be taken on schedule; no tests can be taken earlier than the scheduled date and time.
- A doctor note will be required in order to make up any exam. Makeup exams will be given on Monday, March 11, 2024 at 8:00 a.m. in the library.
- We will be on a regular bell schedule on Thursday, March 7 and on an adjusted bell schedule on Friday, March 8. See adjusted schedule below. We will give 3rd and 4th block tests on Thursday and 1st and 2nd Block tests on Friday.

- At 11:02 all students will remain with their 2nd block teacher and move to the drives beginning at the shop and ending with ROTC and students in Cook in front of the ROTC room
- Once the sendoff is complete, students will return to their 2nd block until 11:21.

At the 11:21 bell, students who are attending the State Championship game will be allowed to begin checking out through the office. Each student must have a parent note in order to check out on Friday and the student must check in with an administrator once at the game. The absence will be recorded as school business, but a note from a parent is required. Phone calls will not be allowed for checkouts for the basketball game. All other students will report to the cafeteria for A lunch or to 3rd Block (if



- they have B lunch) for the remainder of the day on a STAT bell schedule.
- Courtesy of Summerwood Sports the first 200 students will receive a t-shirt and a voucher for a free ticket after they sign out for the game. If you have already purchased a ticket please do not take a voucher.
- Students who receive a voucher when checking out will need to enter the game through the Grand Lobby Entrance on the other end of the convention center from the Bank OZK Arena. Those students will then need to locate Mr. Barger to be scanned into the game.

SOPHOMORES

Some 1st block classes will be relocated on test day. Your 1st block teacher will instruct you where you should report for those times. This information is also posted on the display case. You will be expected to have a reading book and wired earbuds with you on testing day.
