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# WHAT IS TITLE I?

- Title I is the major component of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) and the largest federal assistance program for our nation's schools.
- The goal of Title I is a higher quality of education for every child.
- The program serves millions of children in elementary and secondary schools each year.



# TITLE I FUNDS PROVIDE SUPPLEMENTAL SUPPORT

Our School's Title I funds provide the following supplemental support:

- Additional Personnel to support our students and teachers
- Additional classroom materials and equipment
- Supplemental curriculum
- Small group intervention
- After school tutoring (STEM, Art Club)
- Additional Staff Development

Title I funds can also provide for Parent-Family Engagement activities and trainings throughout the year as well as:

- Parent Nights & Family Nights

# WHO DECIDES HOW FUNDS ARE USED?

- ★ The school's leadership makes personnel and instructional decisions based on the specific needs of our student population.
- ★ Parent input into the decision making process is encouraged through various means including:
  - School Improvement Team composed of parents, community members, teachers, other staff that work at the school, principals and students.
