Please submit bids for the following:

Grout out and clean all existing cracks in asphalt. Fill cracks with hot pour
rubberized crack filler. Place and compact asphalt down to crack areas to help with
reflective cracking that may occur.
Clean courts of all loose debris and tack coat for proper adhesion.
Lay and compact 1 ½" of hot mix N70 surface asphalt.
Adhere to the true plane slope requirements of The National Asphalt Paving
Association and the U.S. Tennis Court and Track Builders Association, available at
http://sportsbuilders.org/page.php?id=17&from%5B%5D=28&
All materials and installation included
The asphalt contractor is responsible for any damage done to the tennis court surface
and any other school property by asphalt installers. Any such damage shall be
repaired at the asphalt contractor's expense.
