

SNOW DAY - eLearning Schedule

Background Information

The district will utilize Remote Learning on days when Mother Nature makes it too risky to travel to school or when conditions deem it necessary by the Superintendent. This allows us to conduct instruction remotely by making assignments accessible to students on school devices and through their instructional platforms (Google Classroom or Seesaw). Student attendance requirements for Remote Learning days are outlined below (by grade level). Families will be given as much notice as possible if a Remote Learning Day will be necessary. The district will utilize phone and text messages, as well as notifying local media of any schedule changes. The district plans to notify every family by 6:00 a.m. on the morning of a Remote Learning event, or the night prior (when possible).

Grade 9 through 12 Attendance Expectations and Scheduling

High School students will be expected to follow their class schedule from home. Students have access to their schedules via TeacherEase. Students are expected to check in at the beginning (prior to the tardy bell) of each class period via the Google Meet assigned by their teacher (this includes study hall). Attendance will be taken. The attendance policy is in full effect on these days. Absent students, who have not contacted the principal, will receive unexcused absences for class periods missed. Students who check in after their class start time will receive a tardy. Students who are present in their class Google Meet will receive a present code of "R" for each period (which indicates the student is attending remotely). If a student is ill and unable to log in on a Remote Learning Day, the parent is to email a detailed note to the principal at hfricke@mtpulaski.k12.il.us. The principal will make a final determination regarding excused versus unexcused absences on a Remote Learning Day. The noon to 2:00 p.m. session is for extended help as needed by students. Students need to email their teacher(s) to coordinate a Google Meet if additional instruction/help is needed during the afternoon session.

Grades 6 through 8 Attendance Expectations and Scheduling
