Prom Dress Code

Sunray High School 23-24

DRESS CODE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED

- Students will be dress coded at the door.
- Students not meeting dress code will not be admitted.
- Students will not be allowed to cover up or alter with temporary measures.
- Students who are later determined to be out of dress code after the beginning of the event will be asked to leave.

Attire may NOT be cut below the bust line. The bust continues around your sides directly under the armpit.

With arms down at your side, if flesh touches flesh below the bust line, the dress is considered inappropriate.



Attire may be backless as long as it is **NOT** cut below level of the naval.

This dress MEETS dress code.
Please notice how the bust is covered on the sides. The back portion does not exceed below the same height as the belly button.



Two Piece Dresses

Two piece dresses are allowed as they meet the following guidelines:

They **DO NOT** reveal more than approximately one inch of the stomach all the way around **AND**

the lower skirt of the dress
MUST be high waisted
(NO BELLY BUTTONS EXPOSED).

KEEP IN MIND RULE ON SEE THROUGH MATERIALS on later slide.




Attire Length/ Dress Slits

Attire may not be shorter than mid-thigh, for most this is around extended fingertip length.

Dresses with one or more slits can not be shorter than mid-thigh, again following the extended fingertip length as a guide.

If a student's attire cannot stay down at this length on its own then it is not appropriate. This includes when sitting, walking or dancing.



Continued:

- NO COVER UPS (coats, shawls, sweaters, etc.) will be allowed over attire that otherwise DO NOT MEET this dress code.
- Attire CANNOT have material that is SEE THROUGH (this includes mesh) to cover up an
 area that otherwise is out of dress code.
- Undergarments should not be visible.
- No visible tattoos showing. They should be covered.
- Fabric inserts must be SEWN, no pinning or other temporary fixes for items that otherwise do not meet dress code.
- WHILE WE WILL BE RESONABLE ON THE INTERPRETATION OF THESE GUIDELINES, we want you to know, YOU WILL NOT BE ADMITTED and can be ASKED TO LEAVE, if these guidelines are not followed.

These guidelines apply to all types of attire.

This includes pant suits, and is applicable to all students and guests.
