Basic Facts about Our Program

What are the age requirements for our students?

- Children must be 4 years old by August 1, 2024.
- We do not accept children outside the above listed age limit.

How many classrooms, students, and staff are in the preschool program?

- We accept 80 children per year.
- We have 4 classrooms with a 1:10 teacher/student ratio.

What are the hours of operation and what is the schedule for the program?

- Hours of operation are 7:30 to 3:00 Monday through Friday.
- We operate 178 days a year and follow the Greenwood Public School Calendar.

Where are the classrooms located and what do you teach children?

- Our classrooms are located in the Westwood Elementary School.
- Our curriculum is center-based, hands-on with social development as a priority.
- We follow the framework that will prepare students for kindergarten readiness.
- Students are served breakfast, lunch, and a daily snack.
- One hour of recess and one hour of rest time daily are state mandated.
- Our program has received a "Level 3 Quality Child Care Rating."

What supplies will my child need for the program?

• All supplies are covered by the program (no additional costs to you).

How is my child evaluated/accepted into the program?

- Acceptance into the program is based on gross family income (chart is included in this packet).
- Children who fall into the "No Fee" Category are given priority enrollment.
- After "No Fee" students are placed, other students are given consideration based on first come, first serve basis.

When will I know if my child qualifies or is being approved for the program?

- When we receive a completed packet you will be notified if your child has been accepted into the program.
