Overview

McHenry Community High School, formerly McHenry East and McHenry West High School, is a comprehensive high school system located 55 miles northwest of metropolitan Chicago. The school district is comprised of two buildings, McHenry High School Freshman Campus and McHenry High School Upper Campus. The Freshman Campus is made up of all 9th grade students and the Upper Campus has all 10th - 12th grade students.

AP^{and} Honors

McHenry Community High School offers 21 Advanced Placement and 39 Honors courses. AP and Honors courses are open enrollment. Teachers recommend students for AP and Honors courses. For more information please see the link on the next page.

Special Notes

Students whose high school entry-level math course is Algebra II, Geometry 1- 1/1- 2, or Honors Geometry have successfully completed an Algebra I class in middle school, which is comparable to the high school Algebra I course.

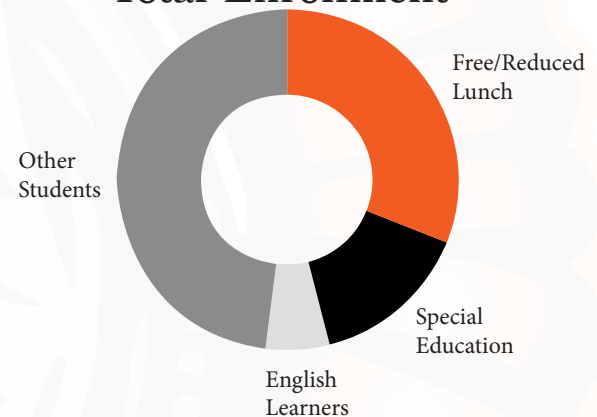
Scheduling

District 156 has a traditional schedule with eight, 45-minute periods each day and a 35-minute support period each day except on early release in-service days. All one-credit courses meet one period daily; two-credit courses meet two periods daily.

McHenry Community High School partners with McHenry County College in offering 26 courses that students can take at MCC or at MCHS.

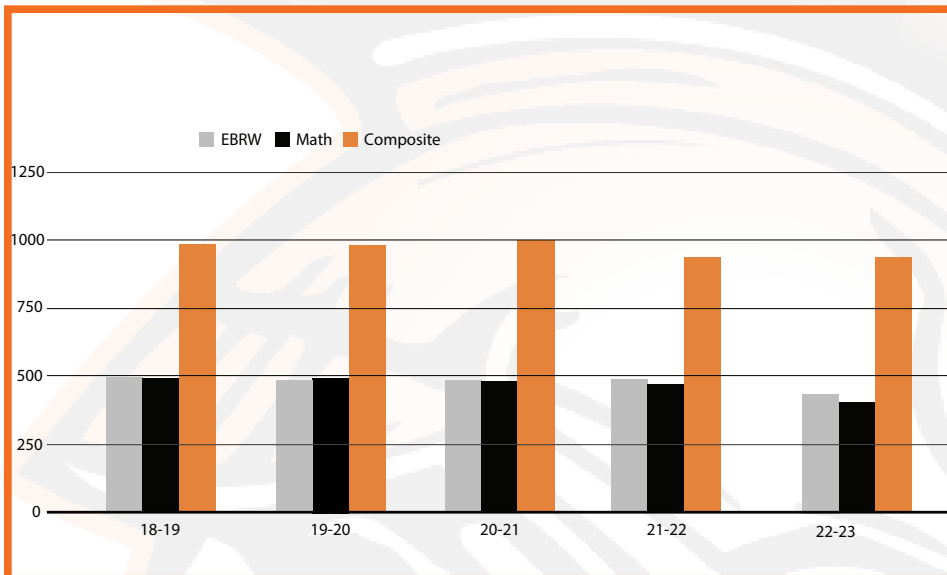
Beginning with the 2016 graduating class, District 156 recognizes students who attained proficiency in two or more languages through the Seal of Biliteracy Award.



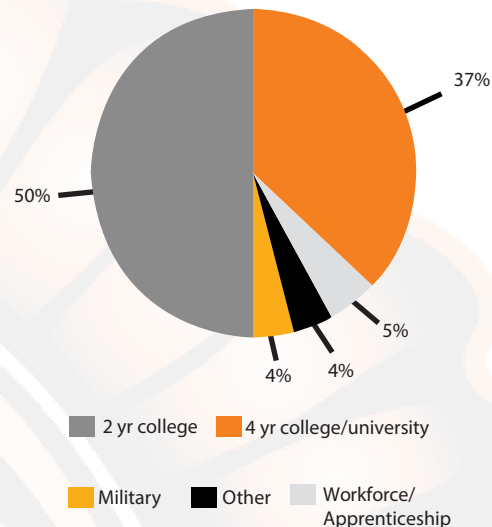
