**16**... IS THE MAGIC NUMBER!

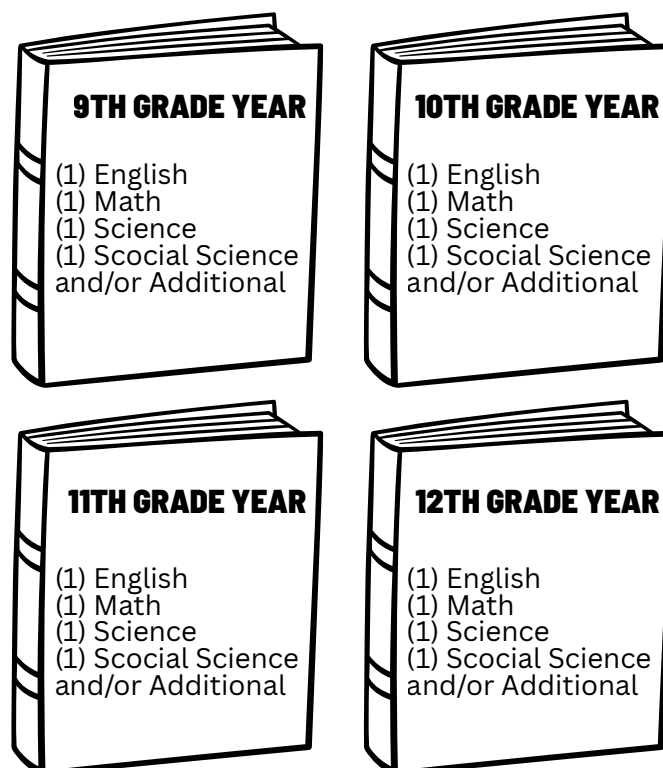
**16** out of the 22 state required credits must have been accumulated by taking the courses listed here. (Plus a core-course GPA of **2.3**)
