Illness Policy Highlights

Students must remain home until fever-free for 24 hours without medication. COVID/flu symptoms require improvement plus 24 hours fever-free. Vomiting/diarrhea requires 24 hours after the last episode. Strep requires 24 hours of antibiotics. Head lice require treatment and no nits. Pink Eye, Ringworm, and Impetigo require 24 hours of medication. Chickenpox, Shingles, Pertussis, and Mono follow district guidelines.
