Required Qualifications:

- Bachelor's Degree in social work, child and family studies, psychology, criminal justice, or education

Desired Experience:

- Experience working with students who have behavioral needs
- Familiarity with positive behavior interventions and supports

Responsibilities

- Assists in the development and implementation of tiered behavior supports, plans, and intervention programs that address the needs of at-risk students.
- Receives referrals and confers with students, parents, teachers, community agencies, and law enforcement.
- Generates and accounts for data collection systems to monitor student behaviors, and the effectiveness of interventions, and makes modifications as needed.
- Thoroughly documents student behavior, communicates and collaborates with parents and staff.
- Supervises students on campus before and after school, monitors students during lunch, recess, passing periods, and other activities; instructs students regarding appropriate behaviors.
- Provides direction to a variety of faculty, staff, and student programs and services; participates and facilitates informal classroom visitations and observations regarding behavior and student success in the classroom and provides recommendations and suggestions for support, as appropriate.
- Participates in general and special education meetings, as well as intervention support teams.
- Operates with a trauma-informed mindset, de-escalation strategies, conflict resolution, and restorative conversations.
- Regular and reliable attendance and physical presence are required.
- Ability to withstand the physical and mental rigors of being a behavior interventionist.
- Other duties as assigned.
