- Must demonstrate the ability to seek out knowledgeable peers, coaches, or administrators for instructional support to deliver high-quality instruction in every class period every day

Preferred Qualifications:

- To successfully work with special needs students in an inclusive setting
- Meeting with parents and staff to discuss student's progress and to determine priorities for student and individualized educational needs
- Provide differentiated instruction for students and make accommodations based on individual student data; ability to identify and incorporate strategic and intensive interventions as dictated by individual student data
- Maintain accurate and complete student records and prepare reports on students and activities, as required by law, district policies, and administrative regulations
- Confer with parents, administrators, psychologists, social workers, and other professionals to develop individualized education programs (IEPs) designed to promote students' educational, physical, and social/emotional development
- Must improve and maintain professional competence by participating in district-provided professional educational opportunities
