Reminders that the following will not be allowed to count as hours;

- Activities in which you are receiving a grade and/or credit of some sort for a class. (Ex, if it is an Ag class project or you are getting extra credit added to your grade, it can't be used).
- Volunteer work for family members. Also, remember that your parents are not allowed to sign your volunteer form, even if they are the event organizer. In this event, another person involved in organizing/running the event should sign your form.
- Volunteer hours done during the regular school day. Exception: If you have early dismissal or late arrival, you can accrue hours during those time periods AND you may receive credit for volunteer work requested by the club during the school day (Ex, Spring Fling).
- Hours obtained for regular church activities (Ex, singing in the choir, keeping the nursery, or other activities during regular church services).
- Hours obtained outside of the regular school year calendar. All hours must be done between August 28, 2023 and the due date (April 19, 2024 for Seniors and May 24, 2024 for underclassmen). Hours for early graduates are due prior to the end of the 1st semester.
- Fundraising events that are benefiting individuals. In order to receive credit for fundraising events, the organization you are volunteering with MUST show that they are using the funds for specific community service projects AND you must include this information in your descriptions. (Ex., your church is doing a plate sale to raise money for a youth summer missions trip).
- Activities with for-profit businesses or organizations.

If you have any questions about whether or not your hours will count, ask an officer BEFORE you complete them.
