

NCAEOP History

In 1951, the North Carolina Association of Educational Secretaries was organized. The name of the association became the North Carolina Association of Educational Office Personnel, Inc., in 1973, and in 1993, the membership voted to change the name to the North Carolina Association of Educational Office Professionals, Inc. Membership is open to educational office personnel and administrators within the educational system (public and private) in North Carolina. No other educational association in this state makes itself so readily accessible to a single professional class of persons who cover the complete spectrum of education.

NCAEOP is comprised of a board of directors which consists of president, president elect, vice president, secretary, immediate past president, and fourteen district presidents. Subject to the NCAEOP constitution and bylaws, the elected officers carry out the functions of the association. Officers of NCAEOP, with the exception of treasurer, are elected and installed at the annual conference in March. The treasurer, appointed by the president and approved by the board of directors, is a permanent position. For a listing of the county and city school districts served by NCAEOP and a map of the state that lets you see the districts click here.

NCAEOP is made up of fourteen districts. At least one district meeting with inservice training is held each year in addition to local unit meetings. Officer positions and committee work allow members to be involved in the decision-making of the association at the local, district, and state levels.

NCAEOP is your professional association. A giant step toward professionalism can be made by becoming a NCAEOP member.

NCAEOP Code of Ethics

Service

Educational Office Professionals should exalt their profession on all occasions and sincerely strive for a finer and more efficient service to the school and community.

Integrity

Educational Office Professionals should be courteous, just, and professional in all their relations with administrators, office personnel, pupils, teachers, and other visitors to the office.

Educational Office Professionals should not disclose any information of a confidential nature and should not do or say anything that would cause them to lose the confidence and respect of others. They should avoid voicing unfavorable criticism of other school employees unless that criticism is formally presented to a school official for the welfare of the school.

Educational Office Professionals should recognize and perform duties of citizenship and should be loyal to the school system, the state and the nation.

Educational Office Professionals should refrain from the use of pressure on school officials to secure a promotion or to obtain favors for other people.

Skill

Educational Office Professionals should perform their duties with dispatch and accuracy.

Educational Office Professionals should maintain their own efficiency by study, by travel, and by other means which keep them abreast of the trends in educational and business practices.

Educational office Professionals should make the office a congenial place for all without allowing it to become a social center.

Educational Office Professionals should practice the qualities which promote good human relations and good public relations: cheerfulness, honesty, tack, and understanding, patience, and good judgment.






Broccoli Soup

This smoothing broccoli soup recipe is thick and flavorful. It is simple, tasty, and quick to make on those cold days.

Ingredients

- 2 tablespoons butter
- 1 onion, chopped
- 4 cups chicken broth
- 4 cups broccoli florets
- 1 can of cream of chicken condensed soup
- 3 tablespoons all-purpose flour or cornstarch
- 1.5 cup milk
- salt and ground black pepper to taste



Directions

- Gather all ingredients.
- Melt 2 tablespoons butter with onion in a medium stock pot over medium heat. Saute until onion tender.
- Add broccoli and broth, cover, and simmer for approximately 20 minutes or until the broccoli is tender.
- Add 1 can of cream of chicken condensed soup
- Using a whisk or a immerse blender blend broccoli florets to your desire texture.
- Mix together flour/cornstarch and add milk. Pour directly into soup while stirring. Stir mixture into soup until thick and bubbly. Season with salt and pepper.
- Serve hot topped with cheddar cheese.

Tid you know?
What's the Difference Between Condensed Soup and Regular Soup?

Condensed soup is essentially soup boiled down to a thick stock, with most of the volume of water removed. If you took a can of regular soup and boiled it down to half the volume, you'd get the same thickness as condensed soup.

1 can of condensed soup prepared = 2 cans of regular soup
