

VLA Program Options 2023-2024

Elementary K-5 Options

Collaborative:

Live Lessons and structured learning activities. Students have required daily lessons through Google Classroom.

Independent:

Students independently participate in daily structured learning activities in Google Classroom with a flexible daily schedule. Students have required daily check in's with their teacher.

Elementary 6th Options

Full Time -Collaborative:

Live Lessons and structured learning activities. Students have required daily lessons through Google Classroom.

Full Time -Independent:

Students independently participate in daily structured learning activities in Google Classroom with a flexible daily schedule. Students have required daily check in's with their teacher.

Hybrid: Students attend the VLA courses in Google Classroom along side in person courses provided by their district. With required daily attendance check-ins.

Middle School 7-8 Options

<u>Full - Time:</u> Students attend the VLA courses as full time students in the Google Classroom. With required daily attendance check-ins.

Hybrid: Students attend the VLA courses in Google Classroom along side in person courses provided by their district. With required daily attendance check-ins.

High School 9-12 Options

<u>Full - Time:</u> Students attend the VLA courses as full time students. With required daily attendance check-ins.

Hybrid: Students attend the VLA courses in along side in person courses provided by their district. With required daily attendance check-ins.

K-6



Collaborative

(Suggested)

This option works well for families wanting a classroom option with live virtual interactions with a teacher and other students. This option works well for families that can provide home coach support.

- ★ Google Classroom is a learning platform that allows for live learning class time, and at home work time learning opportunities.

 Teachers will establish appropriate learning schedules.
- ★ Students are required to attend live virtual learning sessions Monday Thursday according to the VLA calendar. Sessions include daily whole group and small group lessons.
- O Limit distractions during live sessions so students can focus in their classroom.
- \bigcirc Communicate with teachers when student needs to be absent.
- ★ Students will access all information, live lesson links, assignments, grades, communication, etc in their Google Classroom(s).
 - ★ Students are required to maintain adequate progress and required daily attendance in live sessions.
- ★ Students will attend any required resident district events, or lab times.

Independent

This option works well for families that have the ability to provide a dedicated, consistent home coach to support learning. It allows for flexibility within daily at home learning schedules.

- ★ K-5 students will take courses via Google Classroom.

 Students will attend to their studies daily Monday Thursday according to the VLA Student Calendar.
- ★ Learning coaches are responsible for establishing a learning schedule that works for each child and family.
 - ★ There are no required live zoom sessions.

OLimit distractions during independent work time so students can focus in their learning space.

- ★ All K-6 students will be monitored by a certified local teacher that will communicate with families as needed.
 - ★ Students are required to maintain adequate progress and required daily attendance in all content areas.
- ★ Students will attend any required resident district events, or lab times.

HOME COACH REQUIREMENTS

To be successful in virtual learning for both options:

- ★ Support required daily attendance and participation in school.
- ★ Students need a consistent, dedicated adult at home to serve as a home learning coach:
 - O Provide a quiet place for child to learn
 - O Help with virtual and physical learning tools
 - O Ensure assignments are completed and turned in on time
 - O Consistently communication with child's teacher
 - OSupport regular daily attendance at school

We want all students to be successful. Selecting the best learning environment and having an **active and dedicated** learning coach is critical to each child's success.

Communicating consistently with the teacher and school liaison is vital in making virtual learning a successful experience for your child!







WHAT TYPE OF VIRTUAL COURSES ARE THERE?

All of our courses are virtual! We work within several learning platforms:

Google Classroom: Teacher create and set up the entire semester course. It is built by you, with access to previous course shells, pull with supports by access to your district resources and state approved curriculum, VLA supports and supplements courses.

Edmentum/Others: Course content comes pre-loaded, and ready for adjustment as needed to support learning goals and standards. Teachers oversee students moving at a flexible pacing. Contains teacher graded activities and discussions.

WHAT IS THE TIME COMMITTMENT?

This is a great opportunity to make a difference for kids...

Virtual Courses require that teachers of record provide:

- >Daily Attendance >Daily communication with students
- >Academic support via program communication app Rooms >Basic technology support >Communication with staff
- >Attending professional development onboarding at the beginning of the year.
- >Attendance at monthly 1 hour PLC's



WHAT IS THE EXTRA DUTY CONTRACT?



Teachers will be provided an extra duty contract outside of your regular work hours. These contracts range in pay dependent on the platform type and student numbers.

Extra duty contracts are paid at the end of each semester:

Course Pay: \$750 per semester course

- + per student increase or a student cap increase (dependant on platform)
- +Dual Credit increase for all dual credit courses
