Qualifications:

- Must meet health requirements of the State of Michigan (physical required)
- Must possess a valid Michigan driver's license and have a clean driving record
- Must submit to a Criminal Background Check, as required by state law
- Be courteous in interactions with students, parents, and school staff.
- Education: High School diploma or GED

Responsibilities:

- Drive student to and from school every day. (Morning and afternoon)
 - From near Pullman Elementary to Bloomington Middle and High School
- Manage the operation of the school lift van to ensure a safe and hazard-free environment for all students
- Comply with all traffic ordinances and laws governing the operating of a school vehicle
- Demonstrate proficiency in handling and maneuvering a school lift van
- Participate in all required training and in-service
- Perform assigned duties within the scheduled time frame
- Ability to lift and maneuver student as needed
- Perform and properly complete daily pre- and post-trip inspections of lift van
- Will clean and detail other school vehicles
- Other duties as assigned by the Director of Operations
- Comply with district policies regarding student discipline and communication
- Display professional behavior at all times while representing the school district
