CREDIT BY EXAM (CBE)

Information for Students and Parents Elementary and Middle Schools 2023 -2024

NOTE: CBE is for students coming from Texas nonpublic schools, out of state schools or out of the country schools including foreign exchange students. The schools include nonaccredited public, private, parochial school, and homeschool. For students in grades 9^{th} to 12^{th} , please contact your high school counselor.

This letter is intended to provide specific information in which students can receive Credit By Exam (CBE) credit in McAllen ISD. The process for regaining credit begins with students and parent speaking with the school principal. This will ensure that the test to be ordered is the one needed by the student. McAllen ISD cannot accept enrollment for CBE applications without McAllen ISD principal and parent's signature.

CREDIT BY EXAM (CBE)

Credit by Exam (CBE) is offered to 1st to 12th grade students with <u>PRIOR INSTRUCTION</u> coming from a nonpublic school or homeschool students. A CBE test can be administrated at any point of the school year.

Note:

FD (Legal) Records and transcripts of students from Texas nonpublic schools or from out of state or out of the country (including foreign exchange students) shall be evaluated, and students shall be placed promptly in appropriate classes. A district may use a wide variety of methods to verify the content of courses for which a transfer student has earned credit. 19 TAC 74.26(a)(2)

FD (Local) A student enrolling in a District school from a nonaccredited public, private, or parochial school, including a homeschool, shall be placed initially at the discretion of the principal, pending observation by classroom teachers, guidance personnel, and the principal. Criteria for placement may include:

- 1. Scores on achievement tests, which may be administered by appropriate District personnel.
- 2. Recommendation of the sending school.
- 3. Prior academic record.
- 4. Chronological age and social and emotional development of the student.
- 5. Other criteria deemed appropriate by the principal.

Grades 6 – 8

(EHDB Legal)

In accordance with local policy, a student in any of grades 6–12 may be given credit for an academic subject in which he or she had some prior instruction if the student scores 70 percent on a criterion-referenced test approved by the Board for the applicable course. 19 TAC 74.24(c)(9)
