Beavers’ Cross Country Team Performs Well at Flyer Invitational

The Hanson cross country team traveled to Valley View Golf Course in Freeman on Wednesday, September 13, to run in the Flyer Invitational. The varsity boys were the first race of the day. Carson Ferry finished with a 13th place finish for Hanson with a time of (19:27.72). Will Jarding had a time of 21:01.55 which landed him in 28th place. Not far behind W. Jarding was Anthony Geist crossing the finish line in 30th place with a time of 21:30.28.

The efforts from the varsity boys landed them in fifth place as a team.

The varsity girls’ race followed and Eliza Oltmanns finished in seventh place (21:43.00). Elliott Abbey ended her race with a 10th place finish (22:14.24) and Alyssa Moschell had a time of 23:07.93 finishing in 17th. Cadence Jarding placed with a 19th place finish (23:25.82).

The girls’ varsity placed third as a team.

In the junior varsity races, Hanson had two girls compete with Tenly Slaba crossing the finish line with a time of 19:16.06 in 10th place. Kyannah Sweeten ended the race in 26th place with a time of 23:40.09.

Lastly, the middle school boys ran. Mason Dewald placed seventh (11:33.69); Cooper Jarding, 27th place (14:13.15); and Cruze Degen, 39th place (16:18.74).
