Richardson Elementary School Annual Education Report (AER) Cover Letter

January 8, 2024

Dear Parents/Guardians and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2022-23 educational progress for Richardson Elementary School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Mrs. Ann Sheffer for assistance.

The AER is available for you to review electronically by <u>clicking here</u>. You can also view this information at the Oscoda Area Schools website, or you may review a copy in the main office at your child's school.

For the 2023-24 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2022-23. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was identified as "HAS NOT BEEN GIVEN ONE OF THESE LABELS."

The 2022-2023 school year data has highlighted key challenges at Richardson Elementary School, primarily centered around achievement gaps among students. Data from state assessments reveals disparities between economically and non-economically disadvantaged students, as well as academic discrepancies between students with learning disabilities and those without. Despite the school's overarching goal of surpassing state growth standards, persistent gaps in achievement pose a significant hurdle. To address these challenges, Richardson Elementary School has undertaken several key initiatives. Over the past year, professional development has been provided to equip staff with the skills necessary to accommodate the diverse needs of all students, focusing not only on academic proficiency but also behavioral and social-emotional aspects. Emphasis has been placed on English Language Arts, Mathematics, and Social Emotional Learning. Additionally, the adoption of a new

core literacy curriculum in Grades K-5 has been complemented by additional training in literacy. Moreover, professional development related to student growth data and instruction aims to enhance teaching practices, differentiation, and intervention strategies, directly addressing achievement gaps. The proactive use of universal screeners such as the NWEA test and DIBELS helps identify low-achieving students, facilitating targeted interventions to support their success. The commitment to analyzing data from these initiatives underscores the dedication to continuous improvement across all grade levels at Richardson Elementary School.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

1. PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL:

Richardson Elementary School participates in "School of Choice" and welcomes students who accurately complete the process. All pupils enrolled at Oscoda Area Schools grades Kindergarten – 6th grades are assigned to Richardson Elementary School. There is only one elementary school in the district so all students in these grades are assigned to this school. The school also houses the OAS district preschool program, Young Owls as well as GSRP and Head Start preschool programs.

2. STATUS OF THE RES IMPROVEMENT PLAN:

Richardson Elementary is continuing to work on our school improvement plan and the MICIP process. Our MICIP goals are created by our school improvement team, which consists of teachers and administrators. We have student achievement goals in core academic areas and a goal in regards to Social Emotional Learning. We gather standardized testing data from the previous year, data from our universal screeners, as well as classroom data to develop goals for the upcoming school year. We continue to monitor our goals and data regularly throughout the year to help us evaluate our assessments and instructional methods. We utilize data continuously throughout the year to ensure that we are effectively meeting the needs of all of our students. We have a consultant from BAISD come in and work with our school improvement team throughout the year to ensure that the data and our goals are being regularly checked.

3. SPECIALIZED SCHOOLS:

The Oscoda Area School District does not currently operate any specialized schools.

4. CORE CURRICULUM STATUS:

Richardson Elementary School offers all students a comprehensive and rigorous academic program that meets all state and federal standards. The curriculum is aligned to the National Common Core Standards for Mathematics and Language Arts. These standards can be found online at: http://www.corestandards.org/. The Richardson Elementary School Curriculum provides learning experiences in all areas of Language Arts, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science, Physical Education, Music, Art, and Technology. We are continually monitoring and updating our curriculum and instructional practices to meet the academic needs of all of our students. 6. PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES:

Richardson Elementary School historically has excellent parental involvement. Parent Teacher Conferences are held in the fall. For the 2020-2021 school year 86% of our students were represented at conference time. For 2021-2022 we had a 96% participation rate for conferences. For 2022-2023, we had 89% participation. Over the past 3 years, our average engagement percentage for conferences is 90%. We continuously strive to improve our parental involvement within our school.

We extend our sincere appreciation to the incredible community of Richardson Elementary School. The unwavering commitment of our dedicated staff, resilient students, supportive families, and engaged community members has been tremendous. Together, we have faced and conquered numerous challenges over the last few years, demonstrating the strength of our unity and determination. 
