NJ Summer EBT is coming - Summer of 2024

WHAT IS SUMMER ELECTONIC BENEFITS TRANSFER (also known as Summer-EBT)?

- A new-to-NJ, permanent, nationwide program
- Provides grocery benefits to children while on summer break
- \$120 per eligible child for the purchase of nutritious food



Who is eligible to receive benefits?

Any child aged 6-16 who is currently approved to receive NJ-SNAP, TANF, or Foster Care benefits or children aged 6-16 who attends a school that participates in the National School Lunch Program who have been certified as Federally eligible for free or reduced-price meals through NJ-SNAP, TANF, Foster Care, or through an approved school meal application.

Can I still apply?

Yes! MADISON PUBLIC SCHOOLS participates in the National School Lunch Program!! If your child does not currently receive NJ SNAP, TANF, or Foster Care benefits or does not have a 2023-2024 approved meal application on file, you can still submit an application through your child's school to determine if you are Federally Eligible. **Applications and instructions can be found on the links below.**
