Note: There are two snow days built into this calendar. In the event that inclement weather forces additional school closings, those extra day(s) will be made up beginning with March 30, March 31 and April 1. In the event snow days are not used, those days will be given back as follows: April 6 and May 22. High School graduation will not change. For planning purposes, parents should note that the summer blackout dates, on which there are no extracurricular activities, are from July 18 to July 25. Due to the planned summer work related to the Referendum, Madison school buildings cannot open before **September 2, 2025**, and must close by **June 18, 2026**. Students are required to attend 180 school days. The number of single-session days (18) is an exception for MPS, not the norm, and is primarily driven by the ongoing referendum construction and further amplified by the competing needs of the district.

The (18) Single Session Days breakdown as follows:

- (6) K-8 Parent/Teacher Conferences days 12/8, 12/9, 12/10, 3/23, 3/24, 3/25
- (2) 2026 Referendum Construction single session days 6/16, 6/17
- (2) Holiday Related Early Dismissals: 11/26, 12/23
- Last Day of School Early Dismissal: 6/18

While the referendum work continues, the District does not have the flexibility to schedule staff training on closure days without starting the school year earlier, extending it later, or holding training on observed cultural holidays. Two (2) single-session days are scheduled for back-to-school meetings and mandatory annual training. Five (5) additional days are reserved for curriculum and instruction professional development in multiple content areas, including reading, writing, math, and secondary education level assessments. Six (6) K-8 parent teacher conference single-session days are necessary to offer conferences to all parents twice a year while also satisfying faculty and staff contractual obligations. Lastly, the district reserved two (2) single-session days at the end of the 2025-26 school year to ensure the buildings close on time and summer referendum work is not delayed.

The Administration will continue to evaluate the efficacy of the spring conference schedules and its professional development plans. If an opportunity arises to further reduce the number of single-session days for the 2025-26 academic year, it will do so. In the meantime, Madison Public Schools remains committed to supporting students and families by ensuring meaningful and developmentally appropriate instructional time, delivering essential student services and interventions, providing students access to meals, and facilitating after-school childcare opportunities through ongoing collaboration. Despite scheduling constraints, we remain focused on maximizing student learning and well-being.
