Dracut School Committee Goals Approved January 8, 2024

<u>Goal:</u> The School Committee will continue its advocacy for increasing annual Net School Spending towards the state average as well as Capital needs with relevant town boards.

Key Actions/Benchmarks:

- Develop a schedule of meetings with relevant boards (including community input opportunities)
- Collaborate with various boards related to specific projects/issues
- Maintain open lines of communication with town boards

<u>Goal:</u> Via the Joint Education Subcommittee, the School Committee will actively engage with the Board of Selectmen regarding short, medium and long-term needs that are vital to the success of the district specifically and the town generally, in attracting and retaining families and businesses.

Key Actions/Benchmarks:

- Review and potentially revise the Joint Education Subcommittee charter
- Identify and establish goals for the subcommittee
- Establish specific dates of meetings for the remainder of the fiscal year
- Consider developing a narrative that addresses a cost/benefit rationale in support of attracting families and businesses to Dracut and the Dracut Public Schools

<u>Goal:</u> Recognizing the beneficial impact of social and emotional learning on all aspects of interpersonal relationships, the Committee will annually discuss various aspects of the district's social and emotional programming.

Key Actions/Benchmarks:

- Annually discuss ongoing programming efforts
- Annually review data related to all aspects of the district's social emotional program

<u>Goal:</u> Given the importance of providing students and educators with 21st-century school facilities, the School Committee will continue its advocacy for the Campbell Elementary School building project.

Key Actions/Benchmarks:

- Speaking publicly in various settings regarding the importance of the ongoing feasibility study
- Individual members belonging to related subcommittees will participate in relevant meetings and processes

<u>Goal</u>: The School Committee will continue its efforts to enhance its relationship with the community.

Key Actions/Benchmarks:

- Create opportunities for community interaction with the board
- Maintain a meeting schedule of opportunities for Committee members to interact with members of the community
- Attend PTO/Booster meetings and other school events throughout the school year
