



## Harassment Reporting Information

The Upper Valley Career Center Board of Education encourages the promotion of positive interpersonal relationships between members of the school community. Harassment/bullying is defined as any intentional written, verbal, or physical act that a student has exhibited toward another particular student more than once and the behavior causes both:

- mental and physical harm to the student; and
- is so severe, persistent, or pervasive that it creates an intimidating, threatening, or abusive educational environment for the other student.

Ohio Revised Code (3319.321) requires that the Upper Valley Career Center administration semiannually provide the president of the district board a written summary of all reported incidents and post the summary on its website, if the district has a website.
