Our School Community

[Monroe-Woodbury High School](#), with a current enrollment of 2,375 students in grades 9-12, is located in a suburban community located 45 miles north of New York City. Serving a district population of approximately 36,000 with over 65% employed outside the community, its unique location in the Hudson Valley offers the charm of a rural countryside within easy driving distance of New York City. Our diverse community has traditionally offered outstanding support for the school system.

Class Rank

- Students receive a six-semester rank finalized at the end of junior year. [Official Rank and GPA](#) is available mid-October of senior year.
- Transfer students with less than four semesters are co-ranked. A final rank will be computed at the end of the first semester of the senior year – a seven-semester rank. This provides the final decision for valedictorian and salutatorian.
- We use a 100 point grading scale with a minimum passing grade of 65%.
- REPORT CARD AND TRANSCRIPT GRADES ARE UNWEIGHTED.
- CUMULATIVE GPA AND RANK ARE WEIGHTED.
- All subjects receiving a numerical grade, including failures, are used to compute the student's rank.
- If taken in 8th grade, Algebra, Earth Science, Biology, French 1, Italian 1 and Spanish 1 earn high school credit and are included in rank.
- Weight factors of 1.03 (Honors) and 1.05 (College/AP) are used for rank purposes.

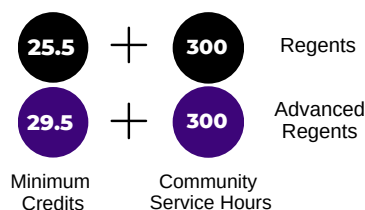
