USD 380 Early Childhood

Classes

- Preschool & Kinder Prep
 - Frankfort Morning Students
 - 8:00-11:30 am
 - Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday
 - Centralia Afternoon Students
 - 12:00-3:30 pm
 - Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday

Enrollment

- Preschool Students
 - To enroll in the Preschool classroom, students must be at least three years of age by September 1 of the current school year.
 - There will be no monthly tuition fee charged for Preschool students who have reached age three by September 1.
 - Applications for free and reduced fees can be completed at the time of enrollment.

• Kinder Prep Students

- To enroll in the Kinder Prep classroom, students must be at least four years of age by September 1 of the current school year.
- There will be no monthly tuition fee charged for Kinder Prep students who have reached age four by September 1.
- Applications for free and reduced fees can be completed at the time of enrollment.

Out-of-District Student Policy

A student will not be able to attend our Early Childhood Program if he/she lives outside of the USD 380 district. Students attending daycares within the USD 380 district are not an exception. You must reside within the USD 380

district boundaries. Exceptions will be made if he/she has a sibling attending either of the USD 380 K-12 buildings.

Enrollment Cap

Capping numbers means that we will be limiting the number of students within each classroom.

• Kinder Prep Students

 There will be a cap enforced, when needed, due to high numbers of enrollment. Kinder Prep will cap at 20 students for each of the morning and afternoon classes.

Preschool Students

- There will be a cap enforced, when needed, due to high numbers of enrollment. Preschool will cap at 18 students for each of the morning and afternoon classes.
- The cap will be enforced when enrollment numbers are high and students will be selected as follows:
 - **Kinder Prep** students must be at least four years of age by September 1 of the current school year. When a cap is enforced, we will take preference for the oldest students until the **cap of 20** is met.
 - **Preschool** students must be at least three years of age by September 1 of the current school year. When a cap is enforced, we will take preference for the oldest students until the **cap of 18** is met.

Required Paperwork

Before a student is allowed to attend USD 380 Vermillion Early Childhood's Program, the following paperwork must be on file:

- Copy of Child's Birth Certificate
- Copy of Immunization Record
- Copy of Current Health Assessment

Arrival and Departure

- Frankfort Morning Students
 - Have your child to the Frankfort school by 7:55 am, unless your child is on the bus route.
 - The bus leaves Frankfort by 8:05 am, class begins at 8:15 am.
 - Students will leave Vermillion at 11:30 am to return to Frankfort at 11:50 am.
 - If you pick up your child at the Frankfort school, please be there when the bus arrives at 11:50 am.

Centralia - Afternoon Students

- Have your child to the Centralia school by 12:00 pm, unless your child is on the bus route.
- The bus leaves Centralia by 12:05 pm, class begins at 12:15 pm.
- o Students will leave Vermillion at 3:10 pm to return to Centralia at 3:20 pm.
- If you pick up your child at Centralia school, please be there when the bus arrives at 3:20 pm.

Extras

- Your child will have to wait in the school office if you are not there on time.
- If your child is being dropped off at home the bus driver MUST see an adult at the house in order for the child to get off the bus.
- The bus driver is also only required to wait 1 minute before going to the next stop.
- If there is ever a change in your child's schedule, please contact the Vermillion School at 785-382-6216!

Inclement Weather

- If there is a two-hour delay for the USD 380 district, there will be NO Early Childhood Classes that day.
- Parents will be contacted via REMIND 101 app and our Early Childhood Facebook page.

Enrollment Fee

An enrollment fee will be assessed to all students who attended the Early Childhood Program. This fee is \$50 per student and will be assessed on Back to School in August. This fee must be paid prior to the start of school.

Snack/Milk & Supply

A snack and milk will be provided for both morning and afternoon classes. A fee will be collected through your payment choice of \$20 a month, \$90 a semester or \$180 a year for the Kinder Prep and Preschool students.

Health Guidelines

- Fever 100.4 or greater- Students must be fever free WITHOUT medication for 24 hours prior to returning to school. If your student is sent home from school with a fever, he/she CANNOT return the next day.
- Vomiting/Diarrhea- Students must have had no episodes of vomiting/diarrhea for 24 hours without medication prior to returning to school. If your student is sent home for vomiting/diarrhea, he/she CANNOT return the next day.
- Influenza—2019 KDHE guidelines REQUIRE that persons with influenza stay home and not attend work, school or other activities for 5 days following onset of the first symptoms of influenza.
 Students must ALSO be fever free for 24 hours without medication before they are allowed to return to school. Students must meet BOTH criteria prior to returning to school. Please notify the school as soon as possible if your student is diagnosed with influenza. Should you need help figuring out when your student can return, please contact me or the school office.

We ask that you send in a set of extra clothes including, shorts, pants, t-shirt, undergarments, and socks. If your child is not yet potty trained, we strongly encourage you to be working on this at home, so it will not impede their education in the classroom. Parents will need to supply the school with pull-ups/diapers if they are not potty trained.

Parent-Teacher Conferences

Parent-Teacher Conferences are held in the fall and spring. We ask that you try and sign up for a fall time at enrollment, if possible. Your child's teacher will be in contact to make arrangements for scheduling your child's conference. Spring conferences are by request only.

Birthday Treats

If you would like to bring treats for a birthday or special event, please notify the teacher at least **24 hours in advance**. Birthday treats are shared at snack time.

Equal Educational Opportunity
