

Dear Parent/Guardian,

The State of Texas now requires school districts to get formal permission from parents or guardians before providing any health services to students.

This means that if you want your student to receive routine care from the school nurse or other trained staff, you must complete a **Health Services Consent Form**. Without this form, we will not be allowed to provide regular health care services during the school day.

Please note: In case of an emergency, your student will always receive immediate care.

How to Give Consent

- Log in to the [Parent Portal](#) and fill out the Health Services Consent Form for each of your students. You will see the Health tab at the top of the page. If you don't have an account, you can register on that page.

If you have not yet registered your student, you will complete the form during your online registration in the [Parent Portal](#).
