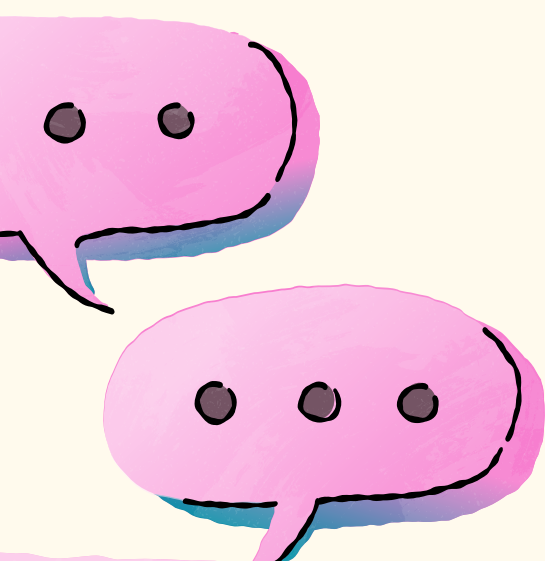

HOW TO BE A SAFE DIGITAL CITIZEN

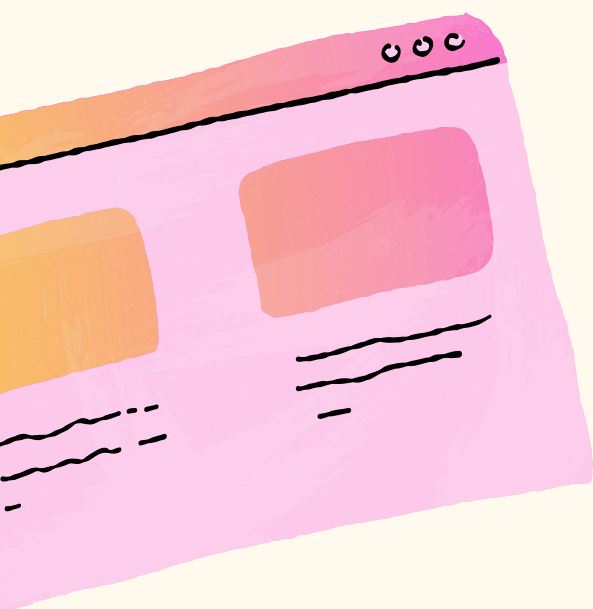


PROTECT YOUR INFORMATION

Consider how your posts might be perceived by others and avoid anything inappropriate or hurtful.

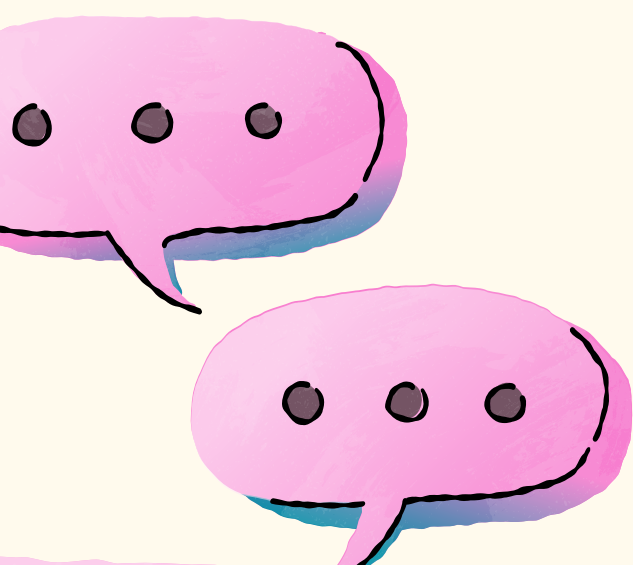
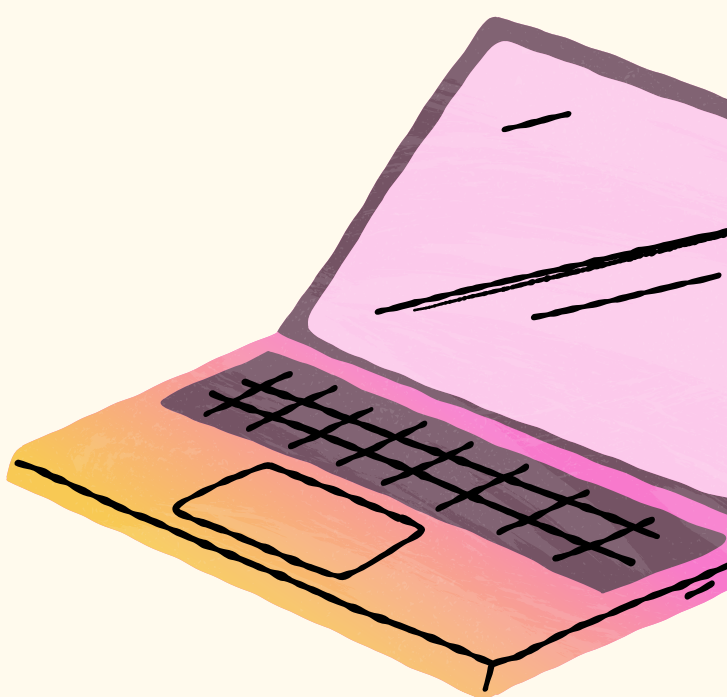


BE A GOOD DIGITAL CITIZEN
