Directions:

In order to be considered as a graduation speaker, you must:

1. Be considered in good standing by the LCHS Administration.
2. Answer the following questions using complete sentences. The answers to these questions should be included in your email to Ms. Cross
 - *Why should you be considered as one of our speakers for graduation?*
 - *Why do you feel you are a positive role model and should represent the Class of 2024 at graduation?*
3. Prepare a draft of the speech you will give at graduation. This speech should be between 2-3 minutes long. A typed copy of your speech must be emailed to Ms. Cross NO LATER than Friday, April 19th @3:30 pm - no late submissions will be accepted!

The short answer questions and **full speech draft** are due Friday, **April 19th by 3:30pm to Ms. Cross**

If your application is accepted for try-outs, you will receive notification by **Monday, April 22nd via email with your time to present your speech to the panel.**

A committee of students and faculty will listen to your presentation of your speech after school tentatively on Wednesday, April 24th. Your speech presentation time/location will be shared via email with you.

It is important to note that if you miss your presentation time, you will no longer be considered as a speaker for graduation.
