The School District

Cassadaga Valley serves approximately 800 pre-K-12 students at one elementary school and a combined middle/high school. Students enrolled at Cassadaga Valley benefit from small classroom sizes, with a student-to-teacher ratio of 11:1. Students receive individualized instruction from knowledgeable, skilled, and veteran educators; more than half of all teachers at CVCS have 4-20 years of experience in the classroom, while a third have 21 years or more.

The District recently received more than \$200,000 in state funding to expand access to its pre-K program. Cassadaga Valley is considered a high-need rural district, with 64 percent of the school community identified as economically disadvantaged.

Cassadaga Valley understands the importance of preparing students for college and careers. Through a partnership with SUNY Jamestown Community College, students can enroll in more than 20 college-level courses and earn dual credit at no charge. The District also offers 26 Career & Technical Education (CTE) courses in a variety of fields.

The District participates in several shared sports programs with neighboring districts and recently earned a Section VI Class B wrestling title. Cassadaga Valley was also named one of the Best Communities for Music Education by the National Association of Music Merchants Foundation this spring, the fourth time it has received this distinction.

The District is undergoing a \$13.2 million capital improvement project approved by voters in 2022. Phase 1, which includes upgraded athletic fields, new classroom lighting and flooring, a new elementary playground, and creek stabilization at the elementary school, is expected to be completed during the 2023-24 school year. Phase II will include art and music room renovations, upgraded ventilation and mechanical systems, and ramp/sidewalk improvements.

Cassadaga Valley demonstrates a forward-thinking approach when it comes to shared services. It now shares a transportation supervisor with the Pine Valley Central School District. CVCS students also attend CTE, Pathways in Technology Early College High School (P-TECH), Special Education, and Alternative Education programs through Erie 2-Chautauqua-Cattaraugus BOCES.

The Community

The Cassadaga Valley Central School District rests in the heart of Chautauqua County in scenic Western New York. It encompasses the villages of Sinclairville and Cassadaga, the hamlet of Lily Dale, and the towns of Stockton, Charlotte, Gerry, Ellery, Pomfret, Arkwright, Ellington, Cherry Creek, and Ellicott. The District covers 138 square miles and has a population of 6,170 according to 2021 U.S. Census Bureau data.

Year-round outdoor recreation abounds throughout the area. There is excellent boating, swimming, and fishing at Cassadaga Lake and Bear Lake. The area is home to thousands of acres of New York State Forests which offer opportunities for hiking, bicycling, mountain biking, and hunting. The Eastside Overland Trail runs through the District along with other trails for snowmobiling and horseback riding.

The wider region offers a variety of cultural and entertainment activities. World-famous Chautauqua Institution – a center for theater, dance, and concerts – is located to the west on the shores of Chautauqua Lake. The National Comedy Center in Jamestown brings in famous entertainers from around the country. The metropolitan areas of Toronto, Buffalo, Rochester, and Erie, PA, are also within reasonable distance.

There are a number of higher education institutions across Western New York that many Cassadaga Valley students have attended, including nearby SUNY Jamestown Community College, Jamestown Business College, and SUNY Fredonia. The University of Buffalo, Buffalo State, and St. Bonaventure are also within an hour's drive.

All of this, combined with a wide range of housing opportunities, provides the Cassadaga Valley Central District with an excellent quality of life for its employees.
