- RCS students <u>underperform</u> compared to students statewide & in similar schools
 - Exception Science 8 & Algebra

NYS Regents

- RCS students <u>outperform</u> students <u>statewide</u> on many Regents exams
- RCS students <u>underperform</u> compared to students *in similar* schools on all Regents exams



District - How are we doing?

District Growth

- FastBridge Early Reading & Early Math Assessments
 - Fewer students at risk in grade 1
- FastBridge "AReading"
 - Fewer students at risk in grades 2 & 3
- FastBridge "AMath"
 - Fewer students at risk in grades 2, 3, 4 & 8




District Priorities - How are we doing? Classroom Performance
