

Vending Machines

The Marion Independent Food Service Department provides an opportunity to the Middle School and High School Students to have access to Smart Snack approved items https://fns-prod.azureedge.us/sites/default/files/allfoods_infographic.pdf throughout the school day, or before leaving for an extracurricular activity.

A vending machine has been installed for students in the cafeteria at the Middle School and High School. Students will have 2 options to purchase snacks and drinks. The first option is with cash. The second option is to scan their student ID card and enter a three digit assigned Pin # and purchase snacks with their lunch account. This option will work as long as the student has a positive balance in their account. If they have a zero or negative balance it will deny them access to the item.

The three digit Pin # is at your discretion to give to your student. The food service staff will not give out the Pin #. To access your students three Pin # and to keep track of what your student is purchasing you will need to log into your families account on Total Access. <http://sds.marion-isd.org/> The Pin # is listed beside each student's name on the Front Family page when you log in. If you would prefer that your student does not use their lunch account to purchase items with their lunch account please have that conversation with them and instruct them to use cash.
