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What is Titans Express?

CCM

We are pleased that you are interested in participating in the CCM Dual Enrollment program. This presentation answers the most Frequently Asked Questions about the program.

Where is this course taught?



Dual Enrollment classes are taught by your high school teachers (in some cases, a CCM adjunct professor) in your high school. They are referred to as Dual Enrollment because the course curriculum you study will enable you to earn credit for your high school class while earning CCM college credits.

Will I receive a grade for the course?



The grade you receive in the course will be determined by your high school teacher based on the criteria they establish. This grade will be sent to the Office of Records and Registration at CCM where it will be recorded as part of your academic record at the College upon completion of the course.

Are the credits college-level credits?



The courses you take through Dual Enrollment will be listed on your County College of Morris college transcript just like any other college course.

These credits can be used to give you a jump start on your college career at CCM. The same transfer guidelines generally apply to these courses as they do for courses taught on the CCM campus, so these credits may also be used if you attend another institution.

Am I considered a CCM student?



As a student enrolled in the Titans Express Dual Enrollment program you are considered a non-matriculated (non-degree) CCM student. You will be provided access to both the Titans Direct student portal and will be given a CCM student email address.

These will provide the foundation for your contact with the CCM community.

All official communication from the College will be sent to your CCM email address. Your access through the Titans Direct student portal will enable you to pay your tuition charges (if applicable) and access your college transcript remotely.

How can I register for the CCM Titans Direct Dual Enrollment course?

Upon submission of the form, your registration will be processed, and you will be enrolled in the program. You will be sent a confirmation to the personal email address you provided on the form verifying your registration in the course. You will also be provided your username and password to access the Titans Direct Student Portal to submit your tuition payment (if applicable). Additionally, you will receive your CCM student ID and email login information. At this point, all communication going forward will be sent to your CCM email address.

What are the tuition charges for the Dual Enrollment courses offered through your HS?

Tuition charges incurred for these courses are my responsibility as the student and parent/guardian and will be payable via the Titans Direct Online student portal.

What are the tuition charges for the Dual Enrollment courses taught at your HS?

Dual Enrollment classes taught at your HS

are billed at a discounted rate of 50% of the In-County per credit rate of \$164.
This means the per credit rate for you will be \$82.00

Tuition for a 3-credit course is \$246
Tuition for a 2-credit course is \$164
Tuition for a 1-credit course is \$82
