



BULLYING, HARASSMENT, AND SAFETY POLICIES

At LMS we strive to help students navigate peer conflicts and unsafe behaviors through collaborative problem solving, restorative justice practices, and adherence to school board policies. We encourage safe choices and positive peer relationships through weekly character education instruction in advisory, PBIS, online lessons that address social and behavioral lagging skills, and peer mentoring. We have ongoing professional development planned for our staff throughout this year to bolster our prevention and response strategies.


