The regular meeting of the Student Health Advisory Committee of Lockney Independent School District was called to order at 4:30 PM on October 18, 2023 at Lockney Elementary School by Brittany Duniven RN.

I. Consideration of Open Issues

1. Discussion of adding sexual health curriculum for 7th grade health
 - a. Mr. Jones brought several book/copies of the extra sexual health curriculum that we could potentially add in to our 7th grade health curriculum. It is optional and an add in to our existing curriculum. If we choose to introduce this curriculum into the health class, SHAC would need to vote and proceed by the majority. We would then need to present this to the school board. This curriculum would not be taught until the end of spring.
 - i. The curriculum is very detailed and some members appreciated the facts it presents while other members were apprehensive with the facts it presents. Some members felt like students should be older to take this course however, it is approved for 7th grade age level.
 - ii. Some members suggested separating boys and girls into different groups to present at least the first chapter content. Mr. Jones states that this could not happen for every class, but could happen occasionally.
 - iii. Parents could opt out of having their child participate in this curriculum. Parent consent would need to occur to have their child participate in curriculum.
 - b. Due to mixed thoughts and feeling regarding the curriculum, we tabled the topic. Mr. Jones states he will have a plan in place of what introducing this curriculum might look like, (having a female co-teach course, splitting females/males when needed, time

frame, etc.). Mr. Jones said he will have this information by our next SHAC meeting in November prior to Thanksgiving break. We will then vote on whether to present the curriculum and add it in to our 7th grade health class, as well as the plan presented, or to not adopt this curriculum at this time.

2. House Bill 3908 – Fentanyl Prevention and Drug Poisoning Awareness Education
 - a. Bill takes effect 9/1/23.
 - b. Billy Koontz and Tony Williams with the Lubbock Drug and Task Force (DEA) has agreed to come speak to our students grades 6 – 12 (and parents if desired) at no cost to our district.
 - i. Mrs. Walker and Mr. Jones agreed that 11/28 would be the ideal date during our 5th and 6th grade periods. Brittany Duniven RN will try to schedule this assembly for that date.
 - ii. SHAC was in favor of trying to incorporate parents to assembly. It was suggested to possibly offer a long lunch to students who had parents attend assembly.
3. DSHS Annual State Immunization Report
 - a. Report opens 10/27/23 and closes 12/8/23. We are currently in compliance with the state regarding immunizations 100%. Brittany Duniven RN will fill out the state report, setting the goal date as 10/27/23.
4. Stop the Bleed training for grades 7 – 12 will take place on November 16th during WIN period. UMC outreach will be here to do skill check off. A short video will need to be shown the day prior.
5. Christian Pierce from the Lubbock Health Department will be coming November 16th to do a drug and tobacco presentation to our 4th and 5th grade students.
