PROGRAM RULES

2024 SEASON



- This program cannot be used in conjunction with any other reading programs.
- Use only the 2024 Roaring Reader Material.
- Tickets cannot be used for group events or school outings.
- Only students enrolled and attending your Elementary School in grades K-6 are eligible to participate. Falsifying student names or including names of those who are not enrolled and attending your Elementary School will result in removal from the program.
- Each student in K-4 who completes 600 minutes, or students in grades 5-6 who complete 800 minutes of recreational reading, can earn one Roaring Reader ticket.
- Teachers who have 10 or more students complete the reading goal, will also receive one ticket. **Homeschool educators with less than 10 students are not eligible to earn a teacher ticket. The teacher ticket is intended to reward teachers with whole classes (or whole schools) for their administrative work.*
- We can only reward one ticket to each student even if they complete more minutes. We can only reward one ticket to each teacher who has 10 or more students complete the goal, even if the teacher has more than one participating classroom.
- Students must read for fun and log their minutes on the Reading Log. Students can read anything they choose for the Roaring Readers program; books, magazines, newspapers, etc. They cannot count any reading that is done to complete homework or school assignments.
- ***** Please Note:** Discount code for free ticket is valid from May 11, 2024 – July 4, 2024 for one(1) FREE Full Day Admission. From July 5 – September 2, 2024, an unused discount code will be valid for two 50% off Full Day admission tickets. Discount codes must be redeemed online or at the ticketing office. Not valid with any other promotion or discount. Tickets can only be used during the designated season. Unused tickets cannot be exchanged or transferred for future seasons.
- Tickets are not for resale and are non-transferable. They may only be used by the individual who earned them.
- Program coordinator or teachers are responsible for submitting qualifying student names online at the provided link to Roaring Springs Waterpark by April 5, 2024. Late entries will not be accepted.



TEACHER INSTRUCTIONS

2024 SEASON



Step 1: Choose a deadline for students to turn in their reading logs to you. You can start the reading period whenever you choose, as long as all submissions to Roaring Springs are completed by **April 5, 2024**. We highly recommend an end date of at least two weeks prior to the April 5th deadline. This will allow any last minute student entries to be submitted so no one misses out.

Step 2: Announce the program to students. Explain to your students that they must complete 600 or 800 minutes, depending on their grade level, of recreational reading to earn their free ticket. Students can read anything they choose for the Roaring Readers program; books, magazines, newspapers, etc. They cannot count any reading that is done to complete homework or school assignments. Students can read independently, parents can read to their student, or students can read to someone.

Students must track what they read and the number of minutes they spend reading on their Student Chart. A parent, guardian, or teacher must verify the time by initialing beside it.

Step 3: Distribute the Parent/Guardian Information and Student Chart. Keep extra copies on hand in case students fill up more than one chart.

Step 4: Send a deadline reminder to all parents/guardians and collect the reading logs from students. Compile a list of students who have completed the required reading.

Step 5: Submit student names via the online roster. We will email the program coordinator a link to the submission site two weeks prior to the deadline. At this site, the coordinator or teachers will submit the names of students who met the reading goal. We recommend each teacher keep a roster of students who completed the reading goal to easily distribute tickets. **All submissions need to be completed by April 5, 2024.** Late entries will not be accepted.

REMINDERS:

- In order for a student to be eligible, they must have completed the required reading minutes. The student must be enrolled at your school and be a current student attending your class. Falsifying student names or including names of those who are not enrolled and attending your Elementary School will result in removal from the program.
- Write the names of the students who submitted completed and signed Student Charts. List each student's name only once. Use a second sheet if necessary.
- Teachers who have 10 or more students complete the reading goal, will also receive one code. Do not include your name in this list. Teachers who have 10 or more students complete the reading goal, will receive only one code, even if he/she has more than one class.
- Keep a copy of this list for your records.
- The Program Coordinator will email you a link to submit the names of students who completed the reading goal. Teachers will submit their student names online. A link will be available **two weeks** prior to the April 5, 2024 submission deadline.

Hello!

This year our class is participating in the Roaring Springs Waterpark Roaring Reader Program. By participating in this program, your child can earn a FREE day ticket to Roaring Springs Waterpark! This program is designed to encourage children in elementary school to read for fun. Each student at our school who completes the required minutes of recreational reading before the deadline is eligible for a free admission ticket via a discount code. We hope that you have fun encouraging your child to reach this goal!

Here's what you need to know:

- Students attending your elementary school in grades K-6 are eligible to participate. Students can only earn one ticket.
- Review the Roaring Reader Student Chart that your child brought home. Your child should use this sheet to record what and how long he/she reads. Please date and initial each reading session.
- If your child is in grades K-4 they must complete 600 minutes. If your child is in grades 5-6 they must complete 800 minutes.
- Your child can read books, magazines, newspapers, or comic books. Reading for homework or a class assignment does not count. Remind your child to return the student chart to his/her teacher by the due date.
LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
