District staff will be able to view responses from the survey on a password-protected online platform. Individual responses to the survey are combined for reporting purposes by group. For example, your answers to survey questions will be combined with those of other parents and guardians. **No one will have access to the answers of individual respondents.**

Students in grades 6-12 will have an opportunity to complete a student survey. Administration of the student survey will take place in the window of March 25, 2024 through March 29, 2024, with each school selecting the timeframe in this window that works best for them. This is a chance for us to learn about your child's opinions about their school, but your child does not have to participate in the survey.
