High school coaches must complete required coach certifications before contact with student athletes. New district employees must pass a criminal background check upon being hired per OAR 581-22-1730; Fingerprinting of subject individuals in positions not requiring licensure.

JOB SUMMARY: This position is responsible for coaching student athletes so that they might achieve a high level of skill, as well as an appreciation for discipline, teamwork, and sportsmanship.

### RESPONSIBILITIES

*Employees in this position perform some or all of the following tasks...*

- Supervise athletes during practices, competitions, and other team-related events.
- Coordinate practices in order to prepare and condition athletes for competition.
- Coach athletes during competition, encouraging them to use their individual skills, while promoting teamwork and sportsmanship.
- Maintain a positive demeanor while interacting with athletes, opponents, officials, and spectators.
- Knowledgeable and compliant with the rules and regulations of the sport.
- Responsible for the proper care and inventory of supplies, equipment, and uniforms. Recommend purchase of such items as needed.
