What is the FAFSA?

If your student plans to attend a career or technical school, 2-year college, or 4-year university you will need to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Each year, over 13 million students who file the FAFSA get more than \$120 billion in grants, work-study, and low-interest loans from the U.S. Department of Education. Many institutions also use the FAFSA to determine which students get financial aid—and how much they'll get. A representative will be available at South Holt to help senior families complete the FAFSA on Wednesday, January 31st at 6:00 p.m. in the South Holt Computer Lab.

FSA ID

The FSA ID is a username and password required for FAFSA completion. Both the parent and student will need to create a separate FSA ID. Click here to see whose parent information is needed for the FAFSA. Students should use a personal email to sign up, not their school email. Visit Days

Students wishing to visit a college, university, vocational or technical school, or job shadow, must complete and turn in a visit day form to the high school office **prior** to the visit. Seniors are allowed two excused visit days for the year which do not count against attendance. Parents may schedule a visit with their child or with assistance from the school counselor.
