     Wednesdays, and Thursdays
  - All Students are welcome to sign up and stay after school, 1-4 days per week, based on their individual needs

# Program Content

- The ESSER program will be based on individual student needs and will offer supplemental instruction/support in any of the following areas:
  - English Language Arts
  - Mathematics
  - Science
  - Social Studies
  - Homework Help
  - Special Education Teachers and ESL Teachers will be available to work with students based on need

### Student Recommendation/Criteria for Program

#### All students are welcome to attend the ESSER After School Homework Club

- Homework assistance will be offered on a first-come first-serve basis.
- Students must sign up for the day(s) they plan to stay after the week prior (or day of if there is room).
  - SALK SCHOOL: Sign ups sheets are located in the main office.
  - SANDBURG SCHOOL: Sign ups will be provided to students virtually.
  - 20-25 students per grade level
  - Students will be assigned teachers daily depending on grade level/subject need.

#### Transportation

  - If parents are not present by the time buses load, students must take the late bus home
