VP Fundraising - Reviews fundraising options for the PTA and coordinates fundraising efforts for the PTA.

VP Student Activities - Reviews school assembly options and coordinates chosen school assemblies.

Secretary - Responsible for all administrative duties (mail/email/social media/meeting minutes).

Current active PTA members may nominate candidates for the McDivitt PTA Board. Self-nominations are also welcome. All nominees must be a current active PTA member in good standing. Previous volunteer experience at PTA events (i.e. volunteered at the Book Fair, Holiday Shop, Class Volunteer, School Store, etc.) is preferred, but not mandatory for this election.


