At the May 6, 2024 general membership meeting, James McDivitt School PTA will be electing officers for the 2024–2025 school year. McDivitt PTA Executive Board positions are typically two-year terms. There are several openings for our next school year.

All board members are required to attend monthly board and general membership meetings, as well as training mandated by the NJPTA. Listed below are the open positions along with a brief description of its duties:

VP Membership & Volunteers - Updates/prepares membership materials for distribution at the beginning of the new school year. Coordinate record-keeping as needed with the President and Treasurer. Report on membership status at monthly PTA meetings. Coordinates school volunteers and recognition for school and PTA events. Leads the Nomination Committee. **THIS IS A ONE YEAR TERM**; THE CURRENT OFFICE HOLDER IS NO LONGER ELIGIBLE.

THE BELOW ARE TWO YEAR TERMS.

Treasurer - Is the authorized custodian of all funds of the PTA. Maintains permanent records to track unit funds and financial transactions. Prepare and present a treasurer's report at every PTA Board meeting and General PTA meeting. Pay all PTA bills as authorized by board. Prepare PTA financial records for annual audits. Ensures taxes and reports required by PTA bylaws, insurance or federal and state governments are completed and submitted by the due dates. Preside over PTA meetings in the President's absence.

VP Fundraising - Reviews fundraising options for the PTA and coordinates fundraising efforts for the PTA.

VP Student Activities - Reviews school assembly options and coordinates chosen school assemblies.

Secretary - Responsible for all administrative duties (mail/email/social media/meeting minutes).

Current active PTA members may nominate candidates for the McDivitt PTA Board. Self-nominations are also welcome. All nominees must be a current active PTA member in good standing. Previous volunteer experience at PTA events (i.e. volunteered at the Book Fair, Holiday Shop, Class Volunteer, School Store, etc.) is preferred, but not mandatory for this election.




