





1. Participating Teams:

Brookings, Belle Fourche, Custer, Dickinson, Douglas, Hill City, Hot Springs, Kadoka, Lakota Tech, Lead-Deadwood, RC Central, RC Christian, RC Stevens, Red Cloud, STM, Watford City.

2. Tournament Information:

- Pool play will begin on Friday at 9:00 am. Teams will be in pools of four teams and play each team in their pool once. JV matches will be played first, with the varsity directly following on the same court.
- On Saturday, only the varsity will play, JV will NOT play on Saturday. The top eight teams will be seeded in an eight team gold bracket, the next eight teams will be seeded in an eight team silver bracket.
- Varsity teams will play three matches on Friday and a minimum of 1 on Saturday, for a minimum of four matches.
- > JV will only play on Friday!
- > JV teams will play two (2) games to 25, win by 2, cap at 31.
- Varsity teams will play the best out of three (3) games to 25, win by 2. The third game, if played, will be to 25, win by 2, no cap.
- > JV teams will follow and play the same time schedule as their varsity team throughout pool play. The JV teams will play first on Friday during pool-play.
- > Two time outs per game will be allowed.
- Times listed are only approximates. Pool-play and bracket play will be on a rolling time schedule. When a court opens both teams should be ready to warm-up for the next match. Team warm-up time will start at the conclusion of the previous match. Failure to be ready may be considered a forfeit. A twenty minute maximum will be allowed only if the tournament is running ahead of schedule.
- The first team listed is the home team in pool play and the top team in bracket play is the home team.
- > All teams will be responsible for providing a libero tracker if needed.
