Class Rank and Grading

Class rank is determined by grade point average. Students are ranked only within their own grade level. Grade point average is determined by multiplying the numerical grade weight of the final grade for a course by the number of credits for that course; this results in quality points, then divided by the number of attempted credits.

Grade Weight:

- AP: A = 5.5, B = 4.5, C = 3.5, D = 1, F = 0
- Honors: A = 5, B = 4, C = 3, D = 1, F = 0
- All others: A = 4, B = 3, C = 2, D = 1, F = 0

Grading:

- A = 92-100
- B = 83-91
- C = 74-82
- D = 65-73
- F = 64 and below
