

Richfield Spring 7-12 Virtual Schedule

In the event that we have no Snow Days remaining and we have to use a day due to inclement weather or emergency, we will follow the VIRTUAL SCHEDULE outline below:

If there is any indication that potential weather will cause a shut down, staff and students will be instructed to take their computers and chargers home, and families will be notified via text/call/social media

What will the schedule for virtual instruction be?

- Consolidated Schedule:
 - This day will count as a regular day of attendance and follow our normal A-F cycle.
 - Students will attend all of their classes between 10am and 2:55pm.
 - A student absence from day/class will be counted as a regular absence and affect seat time requirements

Staff Expectations:

- Ensure all students have access to your Google Classroom classes and have a Google Meet link available
- Provide push-in support staff with Google Meet link (SPED and TA's)
- Service providers (ie...OT/PT, Speech, etc) will also be required to provide Google Meet links on Virtual Days for those student that require their services
- Take student attendance each period (have hard copies of up-to-date class rosters as back-up)
- Provide Instruction during the allotted class time (this is a "normal" day of instruction)
- Engage students
- Refrain from "asynchronous" assignments
- WIN is to be used for providing students with extra help

Student Expectations:

- Attend school virtually following the assigned schedule
 - BOCES students would need to adjust due to not being able to attend BOCES
- Be present and respond when/if called upon attendance counts
- Study Hall/WIN students will be expected to check in with their teacher (a Google Meet Link will be sent to those students)
