Arlington Cemetery - Changing of the Guard, Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, Arlington House, Kennedy gravesites, Iwo Jima Memorial, Museum of African American History and Culture (dependent upon availability), Choice of Smithsonian museums, White House (photo stop), Ford's Theater and Petersen House (photo stops), Souvenir shopping, Lincoln Memorial, WWII, Vietnam, and Korean War Memorials

#### Day 3: Branches of Government and Balance of Power

Mt. Vernon—George Washington's home and plantation showcasing life during colonial times, 18th century treasures, and our first President as farmer and businessman, walking tour of Capitol Hill, Library of Congress - the world's largest library, Supreme Court (photo stop), depart for New York City


