Finance and Facilities Committee Update: Karen Houston, reported the district audit received the highest level of approval with a "Clean Audit,". The Fiscal Dept. provided an update on the budget planning progress for next year. RFPs were completed for a 10-passenger van and a ToolCat. Facilities update included SCMS Roof #9, data closet maintenance and an air handler at Olga Brener in need of repair. Currently auditing cameras and badge access. The Safety Team will tour Belmark. Smudging will be allowed in supervised environment outside. The Hoffman contract was also discussed.

Hoffman Planning & Design Project Contract – Matt McGregor, Director of Project Management, presented information about the future contract if the referendum is successful. A special meeting with the Board would be scheduled. The Design and Construction Manager contract would start right away and kick-off the design process. Construction would follow bidding process. Management will be onsite with site-specific safety plans throughout the duration of the project.
