Potential Risk of Participation

There are risks involved that students should consider as they are deciding whether or not to participate. Students should talk through the pros and cons of participating with their parents or guardians and secondary counselor prior to registering for classes.

- _____ Participation in CCP requires students/parents to complete this form each year and reapply for CCP on their college website (in addition to GPA and testing requirements).
- _____ Students who participate initiate a permanent academic record that will follow them to any other college or university.
- _____ Earning poor grades could negatively impact eligibility for admission at any institution after high school.
- _____ Students who fail or late withdraw from course(s) may be asked by their school districts for reimbursement for the cost of course(s) and book(s).
- _____ Only courses in the Ohio Transfer Module are guaranteed to transfer to other public schools in Ohio. It is up to the parent/student to research if the course(s) the student takes will transfer to non-public schools in Ohio or any out-of-state school.
- _____ Financial aid eligibility as a degree seeking student is based on degree completion within a certain time period. Course credits earned through the CCP program will count in determining eligibility.
- _____ College courses are designed for mature audiences and may be academically and socially challenging for some students.
- _____ Not all college courses will satisfy high school graduation requirements. The High School Course Substitution Crosswalk can inform students about which courses count for particular subjects. The students must still complete all courses required for high school graduation.
- _____ Prior to enrolling in an online course, students must first ensure access to appropriate computer and internet technology. Lack of access may prevent a student from completing assignments and participating in course discussion which could negatively impact the grade earned.
- _____ Students that take more than the acceptable number of credit hours (including high school courses) may be required to pay for the college course that puts them over the credit limit. Careful planning with the school counselor is necessary to avoid going over the credit limit for the school year.
- _____ Students may not schedule courses outside of SWHS building without first having a CCP advising meeting with the school counselor AND college CCP advisor.
- _____ Students will be scheduled into the CCP courses they request as long as they meet qualification requirements and there are no course conflicts.
