North Dakota has an accountability system reported through Insights, more commonly referred to as the “dashboard”. The dashboard contains reports that display the performance of school districts, schools, and student groups on a set of state and local measures to assist in identifying strengths, challenges, and areas needing additional support.

North Dakota’s Insights website is designed to help communities across the state access important information about K-12 districts and schools – including ours. The North Dakota Dashboard features easy-to-read reports on multiple measures of school success, including test scores, graduation rates, English Learner progress and attendance. The Dashboard replaces the former School District Report Card and Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) reports.
