

Frankfort Sunflower Festival Scholarship Fund for Adena High School Graduates

The Frankfort Sunflower Festival Scholarship for Adena High School Graduates was established in 2012 by The International Sunflower Festival Committee. Scholarships will be awarded to Adena High School Graduates as funds are available.

Guidelines for Applicants

1. Nominee must be a graduate of Adena High School, Frankfort, Ohio.
2. Nominee must have not less than a 2.5 Grade Point Average (2.5 GPA) on a 4.0 grading scale.
3. Nominee must complete an application and return it by **May 3rd, 2024**.
4. Nominee must write a self-expression synopsis (250 words or more) describing education goals, career plans, and community service.
5. Nominee shall provide transcripts from Adena High School.
6. Nominee shall provide two recommendations from teachers, coaches, advisors, or other community leaders.
7. The money may be used at any accredited college or trade school.
8. The money may be used for books and/or tuition. Check will be written directly to the student after proof of one quarter or semester from a college, trade school or approved entity. (Example: final grades after a semester)

- Type your essay
- Do not staple any portion of the application or supplemental documents
- Do not fold the application
- Use standard 8.5 x 11 paper to print all application pages as well supplemental documents
- Write your name on the back of your picture
- Type all answers, if possible. To do this, open the application in a word processor and type in the spaces. If typing is not possible, please print legibly.
